May 8, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 2:55 p.m.

1. Mr. Van Cott welcomed all SDMC committee members.
2. Mr. Van Cott shared that the Sagaponack Board of Trustees (BOT) would like the SDMC to review the wording of the Vision Statement that was included in the revised SDMC Plan and will also serve as the tag line of the new Sagaponack logo design. After several attempts to agree on this new Vision Statement, it was determined that the SDMC Plan would be sent to the BOT in June without a revised Vision Statement and the SDMC would continue working on this task during the 2018-19 school year. Essentially, the Plan would be in place commencing July 1, 2018 and would be amended to add the Vision Statement at a later date.
3. Mrs. Payne provided updated information regarding the proposed Sagaponack garden. This project will commence shortly with garden boxes being made first and soil, irrigation and fencing to follow.
4. Mr. Van Cott provided an overview of the proposed 2018-19 school budget. Included in this spending plan will be monies for the following items/projects: re-shingle and paint the south side of the school, screen the school floor, security cameras, science materials, chrome books and a part-time teacher aide. The committee was reminded that voting on this budget as well as for the open BOT seat will take place on Tuesday, May 15, 2018 at the Sagaponack School from 7:30 p.m.-8:30 p.m.
5. During the question and answer segment, Mrs. Albright shared with the committee that she will be stepping down as the SDMC community representative effective June 30, 2018. We all expressed our sincere thanks to Mrs. Albright for her dedicated years of service to the Sagaponack students, staff and community and wished her continued best wishes.
